Springhaven – residents and staff have been very patient and accommodating of the building works. Progressing well with works scheduled to be completed by 18 May. Vinyl will go in next week, tiler will take approximately 3 days then the fitting off and painting. Budget is progressing on track, however one of the existing bathrooms has been leaking and Council were provided a "heads up" of future maintenance works for budget considerations, should the SIHI grant be unsuccessful.
