## My concerns:

- 1) As there are as yet no definitive studies on health aspects of living near turbines, especially of the size proposed, it would seem to put Kojonup Shire in great risk of future claims should they arise from residents close to the turbines.
- 2) Some farming operations will be affected, such as aerial spraying, which may lead to claims for loss of income.

The distance of Turbine setback from property boundaries can be an intrusion on property rights, restricting location numbers where an owner may build residences in the future.

Is there any guarantee that the proponents of the Scheme would alone be responsible in such scenarios?

- 3) Can the Shire of Kojonup be sure it will not be drawn into any foreseen (and even so far unforseen) legal issues?
- 4) Currently there are matters with Moonies Hill Wind Farm proposal that are either vague or being altered over the period available for discussion and decision.

The above are reasons why I ask the Kojonup Shire to delay any agreement with Moonies Hill Energy Pty Ltd until more certain information is obtained.
