10:00am	Visit GD Pork Piggery at Lot 10 Crapella Rd, Boscabel	<p>Members were welcomed by Torben Soerensen who provided a general overview of works undertaken over the last 12 months and works outstanding as part of the Development Approval for the \$14 million project.</p> <p>Members were shown the new piggery sheds, feed mill, transportable accommodation and associated works including partly constructed conveyor belt feeding system.</p> <p>Torben was expecting the bio mass system to arrive onsite in July with commissioning ASAP. He also aims to have the feed mill operating prior to the new year at the very latest.</p>

		<p>on the ground which was bitterly disappointing given underground water lines and overhead power appeared to have been upgraded.</p> <p>The facility was deserted and unloved which raised more questions than answers on the lessee's ability to manage the site! How much funding has been allocated to the site over the years? Have funds been properly acquitted and what community benefit has been derived as part of the overall heritage, cultural and financial planning as a meeting/healing place for past residents and their families and also for use by future generations as the facility is part of a large land holding which receives annual income from the cropping lease?</p> <p>The Manager Works & Services showed members road works undertaken, in progress or planned including an inspection of the Jingalup Tennis Courts which received CSRFF and Council funding. The Courts and facilities are a credit to the Jingalup Tennis Club and in complete contrast to Marribank!</p> <p>The Shire desperately needs rain!</p>
