Lewis: Series 1 - An unrivalled hit on British television and by all accounts, the series Inspector Morse fans were waiting for; **Lewis** ushers in a new breed of accomplished British crime-fighters with a style, wit and intelligence that suggests it won't be long until '**Lewis** and Hathoway' reside amongst the likes of Holmes and Watson.

Cavalcade of Australia 1901-1951: Produced to celebrate the Jubilee of Federation, **Cavalcade** of Australia provides an historical review of the development of the nation between 1901 and 1951. Through the use of historical footage, the film not only covers notable events in the Commonwealth story but also social development, fashions and economic growth over the period.

But when these rootless, demonic spirits descend on a determined doctor, all hell breaks loose Bitten by a dying madman named Jean Pommier, Dr. Eileen Flax becomes the vessel for his turbulent and insane thoughts. Following the adventures of a research scientist who, after taking his Proton Energy Pill, is endowed with the amazing power of twenty atom bombs - for twenty seconds. **Roger Ramjet** is filled with clever puns, cultural references and Hollywood in jokes making it as enjoyable for parents as for their kids

New Adult Fiction

The People of Forever are not Afraid – Shani Boianjiu: A "searing debut" about three young women coming of age, experiencing "the absurdities of life and love on the precipice of violence" ("Vogue") Yael, Avishag, and Lea grow up together in a tiny, dusty Israeli village, attending a high school made up of caravan classrooms, passing notes to each other to alleviate the universal boredom of teenage life. When they are conscripted into the army, their lives change in unpredictable ways, influencing the women they become and the friendship that they struggle to sustain. Yael trains marksmen and flirts with boys. Avishag stands guard, watching refugees throw themselves at barbed-wire fences.

Ryders Ridge – Charlotte Nash: ROMANCE. AUSTRALIAN. Daniella came to the small country town of Ryders Ridge to heal herself. Shaken after a tragic incident in a large city hospital, and feeling the pressure from her esteemed surgeon father, she figures the north-west Queensland cattle town is just the place to escape. Caring and dedicated, she soon wins the trust of her patients, and the attention of handsome and ambitious station heir, Mark Walker. As their relationship grows, Daniella begins to believe she could make a new life in Ryders, and forget what has gone before. But small towns have their own problems.

Queen of Kings – Maria Dahvana Headley: FANTASY. What if Cleopatra didn't die in 30 BC alongside her beloved Mark Antony? What if she couldn't die? What if she became immortal? "Queen of Kings" is the first instalment in an epic, epoch-spanning story of one woman's clash with the Roman Empire and the gods of Egypt in a quest to save everything she holds dear. As Octavian Caesar (later Augustus) and his legions march into Alexandria, Cleopatra, Queen of Egypt, summons Sekhmet, the goddess of Death and Destruction, in a desperate attempt to resurrect her husband, who has died by his own hand, and save her kingdom. But this deity demands something in return: Cleopatra's soul.
